- Payment: Payment for sold items will be made by the fifteenth of the month following the month the item was sold. (Example: item sold June 1st, 2004 -% will be paid to artist by the 15th of July 2004.)
Demonstrating Artist receive 85% of the selling price. Non-Demonstrating Artist 65% of the selling price.
- Demonstrating Artist: Required to demonstrate their craft or artistry for a minimum of 20 hours within a 6 month period.
- The Store Manager has the ultimate authority on what items will be accepted for consignment. The Store Manager also reserves the right to display items as he/she deems fit and beneficial to the shop. Artists are encouraged to make suggestions, but will not rearrange their items or any other items in the shop without the manager's permission
- If after 90 days the merchandise is not selling, the manager may request that certain items be removed for the benefit of the shop and the artist
- Returns: Consignor agrees that consignee has no responsibility for payment of any merchandise which is returned after 90 days.
- Liability: Consignee accepts the above merchandise and is responsible for normal care and protection. Consignee will pay consignor for all merchandise which is lost or damaged due to improper storage, improper handling or customer activity
